Generations of parents and children instantly recognize the signature illustrations that have made Bill Martin Jr. and Eric Carle's Bear books among the most beloved classics in all of children's literature. Before his passing in 2004, Martin left Carle with a manuscript for a fourth and final collaborative Bear book. Now, in celebration of the 40th anniversary of the publication of their first Bear book, *Brown Bear, Brown Bear What Do You See?*, the duo returns with its final collaboration, *Baby Bear, Baby Bear, What Do You See?* (Henry Holt and Company Books for Young Readers). This final book reveals a baby bear's quest to find his Mama Bear. The new title features native North American animals, such as a red fox, a prairie dog and a rattlesnake.
